

DRIVEWAY SAFETY

DRIVEWAYS:

- Before getting into car, check to make sure there are no children under or behind the car. If children are outside, have them stand away from the car with another adult until you have left the driveway.
- Try and park your car so that you can pull forward, instead of having to back out.
- Do not use driveways as play areas. Find a safe spot for your child that is away from all parked or moving cars.
- Pick up any toys, bikes, chalk or other play items near the driveway that could attract children.

PARKING LOTS:

- Help your children in and out of the car. Firmly hold their hands when you are around moving cars and be sure that your child is visible to other drivers.
- Check to be sure there are no children behind or under your car before driving away.
- Be especially careful around daycares and schools during drop-off and pick-up times. Children may be difficult to see, as they are running to meet their caregivers.
