# LAUNDRY PACKETS

## USING AND STORING:

- Laundry packets come in packaging that is easy for children to open so make sure to keep them stored up and away or in a locked cabinet after every use.
- If you have children under 5 years of age, reconsider the use of laundry packets as this age group is most likely to mistake packets for toys or treats.
- If you do use them, try to use packets when your children are not around, like during naptime.

## IF YOU THINK THERE'S A PROBLEM:

- Symptoms may include:
  - Mild stomachache
  - Vomiting
  - Coughing
  - Choking
  - Wheezing
  - Gaspings
  - Eye pain or irritation
  - Drowsiness

- Call 911 immediately if your child is unconscious, not breathing, or having seizures.
